Arranger's note

One by One is a Hokkien song inspired by the Penang Hokkien dialect and Penang Peranakan culture. Originally composed by Johny Chee, an advocate of the Hokkien and Peranakan culture, he spent much of his life teaching and promoting these wonderful cultures to the younger generation. The song, with its witty and subtly provocative sarcasms, is essentially a social commentary about a hero who does not act like one.

Lyrics English translation

One by one, hero bei kuei kuan
Two by two, hero bin tu tu
Three by three hero hoh lang tui
Four by four, hero bin oh-oh
Five by five, hero hoh lang sai
Six by six, hero k'un tit-tit

Aneh macam chou hero, Sau chit liap, sui-sui tou. Hoh lang t'ei ee huan lou, Lu k'nua-a kei bou bou kei bou. One by one hero's battle is lost, Two by two hero's feeling rather blue, Three by three hero now must flee, Four by four hero's not happy anymore, Five by five hero must survive, Six by six hero is in a fix.

How can this be called a hero? When he is vanquished with one blow. And letting others only to worry so, Well, is he a chicken, yes or no?


